Explicitly allport mentions, personality regularly grows and changes. In general, personality is the overall way in which an individual reacts and interacts with other individuals. Personality is most often described in terms of measurable traits aimed at by a person. In addition, personality is often interpreted as characteristics that stand out in individuals. In the book Psychology of Child and Adolescent Development it is explained that the adolescent phase is a very important segment of individual development, which begins with the maturation of physical (sexual) organs so that they are able to reproduce. (Joseph, 2009:184). In Islam, etymologically the sentence juvenile comes from murahaqoh, the verb is raahaqo meaning al-iqtirab (near). Terminology means approaching maturity physically, mentally and mentally as well as socially. (Al-Mighwar, 2006:55). This intellectual transformation typical of the adolescent way of thinking allows it to achieve integration in adult social relationships, which in reality is a common characteristic of this period of development.
